

## ATI Aerospace Technology and Innovation Awards – Terms and Conditions

By submitting an entry to the ATI Aerospace Technology and Innovation Awards, you agree on behalf of your organisation, team or named individual to the following conditions:

- All entries must be submitted by the published closing date and time (23:59 on Monday 7th September 2026). Entries submitted after this date will not be considered.
- Projects or activity submitted must have taken place in the UK.
- You must not make a submission that you know or suspect is inaccurate, false, misleading or contains infringements on the intellectual property rights of any third party. Any submissions deemed to be non-compliant at our sole discretion will be disregarded.
- You can submit a nomination on behalf of yourself or another team, project or organisation.
- Submissions can only be made online via the nomination form and cannot be amended once submitted.
- After the submission deadline, entries cannot be edited but can be withdrawn by requesting this by email to [info@ati.org.uk](mailto:info@ati.org.uk).
- You give the ATI and its selected partners the right to publish the content of your submission in part or in full unless expressly stated. If you include commercially sensitive information, you must clearly mark this as such.
- By submitting images and/or videos you give ATI permission to use these indefinitely, unless stated in the submission. If people appear in your images, please ensure you have the necessary permissions in place.
- The ATI reserves the right to reallocate submissions to another category if deemed to be a better fit.
- Judges will be required to declare any conflicts of interest.
- The judging panel's decision is final and unfortunately we cannot provide feedback on unsuccessful submissions.
- On Thursday 1st October 2026, the ATI will announce the submissions that have been shortlisted in each category. Each shortlisted submission will receive one free ticket and up to 4 discounted tickets to the ATI Conference 2026 (17th & 18th November 2026 at the ICC Wales in Newport).
- The winner of each category will be announced at the ATI Conference 2026, with the winners invited onto the stage to collect their award.
- Winners must agree to a short video interview conducted at the conference. This will be recorded and used in post-awards promotion. A copy of the video will be provided to each winner.
- The ATI reserves the right to amend or cancel these awards without notice.
- The awards are unconnected to the ATI Programme. Submission to the awards and the selection of the winner has no bearing on any past, present or future review of projects by the ATI Programme or any other grant scheme operated by partners of the ATI Programme (the Aerospace Technology Institute, the Department for Business & Trade and Innovate UK).
